THE NO BODY CONTACT ADVISORY HAS BEEN LIFTED FOR SUGAR ISLAND TOWNSHIP PARK

Bacteria levels, specifically E. coli, are currently at safe levels for coming into contact with the water at Sugar Island Township Park.

The advisory to avoid body contact with surface waters at Sugar Island Township Park beach has now been lifted.

Monitoring efforts by the Chippewa County Health Department's Environmental Health staff will continue throughout the summer season.
